Course synopsis:

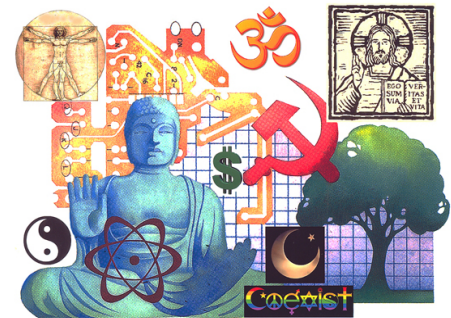
“Dear friends, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world....

Although relatively few people have a well-developed theology or philosophy of life, everyone has a worldview – a set of basic assumptions by which they process reality and attempt to make sense of life. Regardless of their religious orientation and affiliation, everyone has basic presuppositions and beliefs regarding issues such as...

- Who (and what) am I?
- Where did I come from?



- What am I doing here?
- Does my life have any meaning and purpose?
- Is there a God – and if so, how do I know Him?
- Is there a moral law to which I am accountable?
- What happens to me when I die?
